- Data Processing
- Help Desk Support
- Hosting Solutions
- Information Storage and Retrieval
- Network Management — LAN/WAN design, server activities and e-mail support
- Staff Augmentation — If less than 50 percent of the insured's operations
- System Engineering — System analysis, hardware and software design, testing and system evaluations
- System Integration on Management Information Systems
- Training and Development — Software application and operating systems training
- Website Development — From design to support functions

Ineligible: Consulting or programming activities related to aeronautics or aviation

Telecommunications

- Telecommunications Equipment — Design and installation of telecommunication systems
- Telecommunications Service Provider — Provider of airtime, including local, long distance, cellular or satellite communications

Ineligible: Communication systems tied into military navigation systems
